Project Assistance in Transition from Homelessness (PATH)

- Program dedicated to serving the needs of homeless, at-risk of homelessness, or struggling with a serious mental illness.
 - Navigators
 - Central, East, and West areas of the valley
 - Engage homeless individuals and assist with connection to resources
 - Food, housing, employment, mental health, substance use
 - CE intake site
 - Complete VI-SPDAT for housing resources
 - Place on BNL for housing
 - Behavioral Health Professional
 - Assist with coordination into services
 - Assist with the completion of an SMI evaluation and follow-up
 - Reconnect individuals with an SMI designation to their clinics

Phoenix Rise Outpatient Program

- Collaboration between CBI clinical services department and the Human Services Campus.
 - Outpatient Behavioral Health Services
 - Counseling
 - Individual Counseling
 - Group Counseling
 - Peer Support-Navigation
 - Case Management
 - Peer Support
 - Access to Nurse Practitioner
 - Connection to medication assisted treatment
 - Assist with the completion of an SMI evaluation
- Emergency Medical Technicians
 - Respond to medical emergencies
 - Staff with Triage RN
 - Coordinate with outreach teams to transport to facilities
